The Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH) developed a publication titled, Best Practices Guide: Full Height Basement Insulation in anticipation of the change to the Ontario Building Code on January 1, 2009 that mandates near full height basement insulation in new housing.

The guide is intended to help builders build the high performance basements that their customers want.

The guide introduces both the Code minimum requirements and those practices that extend beyond the Code to build a firm understanding of materials, components and system used in the basement and how they interact.
